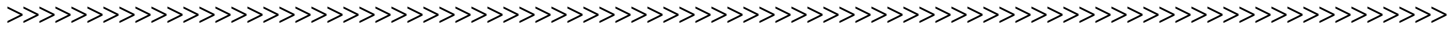






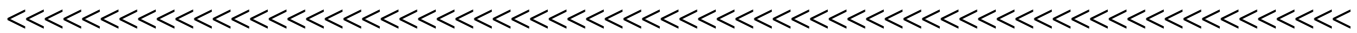
On August 5th, Zion hosted a rest stop at The Best Dam Bike Tour for MS (150 mile bike ride that raises money for MS research and treatment).

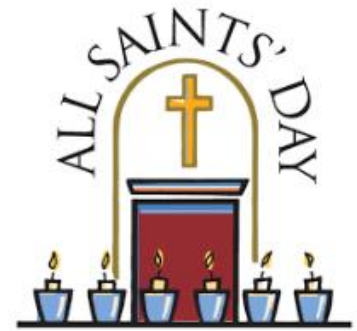
*Reminder:* Piggly Wiggly prefers the receipts not be rolled and rubber banded. Flat and/or folded is okay.
